The Community Development Society (CDS) is an international association of community development professionals. The Community Development Society furthers community work through teaching, practice, and research. CDS provides those who do community work with discussion of best practices, networking opportunities, tools, and other resources.

CDS is seeking reviewers to critique articles for *CD Practice*, a web-based publication that presents innovative tools, research and practice that can be readily applied by community development practitioners. The articles, which are no longer than 3,500 words in length, describe promising practices on all aspects of community development.

For that reason, we seek reviewers for *CD Practice* who represent both theory and practice from all fields and areas of community development.

Expectations of Reviewers

Reviewers will be expected to:

- Review up to four submissions a year, using available criteria to assess the value of articles to community development professionals and judging whether articles should be published on-line.
- Support the integrity of the double-blind review process.
- Provide expert judgment about the value and viability of submissions.
- Support *CD Practice* by promoting the opportunity to submit to and review the publication among colleagues in the field of community development.

Publishing Process:

Papers are blind reviewed by two or three CDS reviewers who have expertise related to the subject in the paper. Reviewers will have two weeks to review and provide comments on the paper. **To apply to be a reviewer**, complete the attached form providing your contact information, experience, and fields of knowledge.
